A FEW WORDS ABOUT PROSTATE CANCER

PROSTATE CANCER

Prostate cancer is the most common form of cancer in men. It generally progresses at a fairly slow pace. When detected early, it is highly curable. Nowadays, advanced

Thanks to research, diagnosis and early treatment of the disease, as well as the availability of more effective treatments, the five-year relative survival of prostate cancer is 96%. It's up to you to take action!

techniques are used to produce an extremely accurate diagnosis. In addition, new and more effective means of treatment make it possible to halt or slow the progression of the disease.

In most cases, the prognosis is good. The exact causes of prostate cancer remain largely unknown, but research has highlighted certain risk factors.

- Racial origin
- Lifestyle
- Diet and physical inactivity
- Various environmental factors



MAKING A DIFFERENCE


Since 2003, with the support of its partners and loyal employees, PROCURF has:

- invested \$4 million in research on prostate cancer through its biobank
- responded to over 5,000 calls and emails from men with prostate cancer and their families
- organized over 300 conferences for the general public across Quebec about the disease, the importance of screening and the forms of treatment.



HIGHLIGHTS OF 2013

- The creation of the Marvyn Kussner Memorial Fund following the death of the Chairman and Founder of PROCURE Marvyn Kussner in June 2013; this was an major financial boost for the biobank.
- The beginning of the distribution of biobank samples for two pilot projects in Quebec and the United States: the characterization and complete genome analysis of prostate cancer, and research of new cancer recurrence markers.
- The PROCURE Biobank/Cancer Research Society Partnership, an investment of \$4.5 million over five years made possible by the generous support of major donors and foundations: Lemaire Family Foundation, Roasters Foundation, Mirella and Lino Saputo Foundation, Antonopoulos Group, Carolyn and Richard Renaud and the Marvyn Kussner Memorial Fund.



MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Dear survivors, caregivers, volunteers, donors, Board members and loyal partners of our cause, I am greatly honoured to present PROCURE's 2013 Annual Report.

PROCURE has its roots in the vision of one man, Marvyn Kussner, who fought prostate cancer and wanted to establish an organization to educate and support those concerned with this diagnosis and to advance scientific research in this area. As a result, Montréal leaders involved in this cause and engaged in the fight against prostate cancer, with the assistance of exceptional business and scientific leaders and consultants, created PROCURE together with Marvyn Kussner.

Sadly, Marvyn Kussner passed away in 2013, but he was able to infuse energy and determination to PROCURE, an organization that I have had the honour to lead over the past five years. PROCURE is the main province-wide organization involved in the fight against prostate cancer. Its mission is founded on three main pillars: supporting scientific research using the biobank, reaching out to men and their families, and offering patient education and support.

PROCURE's prostate cancer biobank marks the implementation of a comprehensive plan developed between 2003 and 2006 and a partnership with the four major Quebec university hospitals (CHUM, MUHC, CHUS, and CHU de Québec). Fully operational since 2007, it complies with high-level standard operating procedures.

In 2013, PROCURE partnered with the Cancer Research Society, providing an investment of \$4.5 million over five years and additional support for research initiatives on prostate cancer. This partnership was made possible through the support of major donors, including the Marvyn Kussner Memorial Fund – a major legacy to the biobank - and the Lemaire Family Foundation, Roasters Foundation, Mirella and Lino Saputo Foundation, Antonopoulos Group and Carolyn and Richard Renaud.

Reaching out to men and their families, as well as educating and supporting patients: these are PROCURE's two main goals. We have developed several tools to help us achieve these goals - a fully bilingual website, a first-line telephone service, education and information lectures, screening activities, and of course events targeting different groups such as the PROCURE Walk of Courage, the PROCURE Tour of Courage, the PROCURE Challenges, and various fundraising events. PROCURE has also expanded its scope in 2014 by supporting the first support group for people with prostate cancer.

PROCURE's first ten years were great. I must pay tribute to all those who contributed to this cause. They include the late Luc Beauregard, who was an active member of the Board and its

committees from the very first. Also, Malvina Klag, who was our Executive Director for several years and whose energy and perseverance have helped implement PROCURE's vision. Today, PROCURE is under the leadership of Laurent Proulx, its current Executive Director, who will support the organization over the coming years.

Achievements arising from several years of intensive work, an overall increase in our business activities, a healthy financial position, a common vision and recognition for our high quality standards in research are among the factors behind the growth of PROCURE.

Along with Laurent Proulx and his team, our spokesmen Jean Pagé and Winston McQuade, our partners, ambassadors and volunteers, and the medical community, in the coming years we will try to improve the three pillars of our mission, in particular our support for men, survivors, caregivers and their families.

Thanks to your support, the coming years will be rich in achievements, and we are confident that our efforts of the first ten years will fuel PROCURE's growth in the future.

During the celebrations held for PROCURE's 10th anniversary in 2013, we were saddened by the death of its founder, Marvyn Kussner. Marvyn leaves us with an extraordinary legacy: he supported thousands of Quebecers fighting prostate cancer, and he called on the scientific community to carry out the research required to better understand and treat this disease. As a determined leader and the leading force at PROCURE, he fought tirelessly to enact real change in the lives of those affected by the disease. Nowadays, PROCURE is recognized as the force against prostate cancer. His wife, Sheila Kussner, has perpetuated his legacy by creating the Marvyn Kussner Memorial Fund in 2013, providing a significant financial contribution to the biobank.

MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Over the next decade, thanks to an energetic Board of Directors and a well-grounded mission, we will advance on our three key objectives - awareness, education and support – while leading in cutting-edge research. Over the next two years, our priorities will be to invest significantly in projects that improve the range of our services for Quebecers affected by this disease, enhance the investment made through the PROCURE Biobank/Cancer Research Society partnership, develop our information and grant management technology, and optimize the allocation of our funds and our administrative expenses.

The achievements of 2013 continued to strengthen PROCURE's positioning as a provincial organization dedicated to prostate cancer. Financially, PROCURE generated revenues of \$1,863,753 million, while investments in our research biobank and in our awareness, education and support programs accounted for 58 % and 28 % of expenditures over the year, respectively.

The world-wide scientific community now has access to the biobank – our innovative research tool bringing together a wide range of samples and data from over 2,000 Quebecers affected by prostate cancer. The biobank began the process of distributing samples between two pilot projects: a project in Quebec on new cancer recurrence markers, and a project at the US National Human Genome Research Institute for the characterization and full genome analysis of prostate cancer. In addition, a data and biospecimen allocation and quality control committee has been created to review future requests. The impact of this work will lead to advances that will help achieve a better understanding of cancer and find new treatments.

In terms of education and support, let us not forget our partners, employees and urologists and their support teams, who strengthened PROCURE's educational and outreach activities. Their contribution helped PROCURE increase its visibility through activities such as power breakfasts in Sherbrooke featuring information on men's health, an information centre at FADOQ's trade show, the annual urologists' conference and other seminars and taking part in symposiums and major conferences on cancer.

Also, our fully overhauled website and our new YouTube channel make it possible for all those affected by prostate cancer to browse the latest news about the disease and its treatments, read testimonies from brave men and women, ask questions or view our information such as the Cancer de la prostate – une affaire d'hommes et de femmes presentation by

Dr. Fred Saad in the fall of 2013; this included the testimony of three women who spoke of their role in supporting loved ones who have this form of cancer.

In addition, the region of Brome-Missisquoi has become affiliated with PROCURE as a prostate cancer support and awareness group, a major step in the development of our network across the province over the next few years. This reinforces our mission to deploy our services to survivors and the 4,600 men who are newly diagnosed each year in Quebec. We are determined to continue working with our ambassadors and other health professionals and organizations in the fight against cancer.

In closing, 2013 was certainly a hectic year that brought some new projects. The success of PROCURE's flagship events such as the Tour of Courage PROCURE, the Walk of Courage PROCURE and the PROCURE Challenges, of third party events described in this report such as Les Femmes de course, the St-Jeansur-Richelieu Walk and the Bowtie Affair, combined with the generosity of donors in our fundraising campaigns, has raised awareness among thousands of people with respect to prostate cancer and generated donations exceeding \$1.1 million.

Those results would not have been possible without your

precious support for which we are deeply grateful. Our thanks also go to our directors who, throughout the year, have given us their tireless support and valuable assistance. I also want to honour the crucial contribution of volunteers and participants to the success of our events.

This annual report highlights the significant events of 2013 and shows how they relate to our strategic planning.

I hope you will enjoy reading it.

COMMITTED SPOKESMEN

In 1995, when I was diagnosed with prostate cancer, I received support and encouragement, and people around me have really helped me overcome this dark period in my life. They just remained who they were: affectionate, playful children, maybe a little more loving, but nothing really changed. Without realizing it, they became wonderful caregivers. 

PROCURE's prostate cancer biobank was launched in Quebec in 2007 to meet the urgent needs of the biomedical research community that was lacking adequate equipment to study this disease. The biobank is a collaborative project between PROCURE, four medical faculties in Quebec (CHUM, MUHC, CHUS, CHU de Québec) and the Fonds de recherche en santé du Québec. The biobank collects, processes and stores biological materials, clinical information and sociodemographic data from men having undergone prostate cancer surgery.

THE BIOBANK OF HOPE

PROCURE's biobank knows that its samples and data will strengthen research, increase the quality of results, and ultimately improve care for patients. It wants to foster the advancement of knowledge on issues such as risk factors or factors that contribute to the development of the disease.

The PROCURE Biobank/Cancer Research Society Partnership was made possible through the support of major donors, including the Marvyn Kussner Memorial Fund - a major legacy to the biobank – and the Lemaire Family Foundation, Roasters Foundation, Mirella and Lino Saputo Foundation, Antonopoulos Group and Carolyn and Richard Renaud.

The potential for scientific research to impact the process from laboratory discovery to clinical practice is far greater when based on repeated biological sampling and information gathering over time, allowing for the standardized collection of data. Matching samples with regularly updated clinical information will make it possible to obtain significant

results and accelerate breakthroughs in this field. PROCURE wants researchers' findings to have their full impact by being quickly implemented in clinical settings.

In 2013, PROCURE and the Cancer Research Society established the PROCURE Biobank/Cancer Research Society Partnership to properly support the biobank. This partnership represents an investment of \$4.5 million over five years and will provide additional support for prostate cancer research initiatives.

NEXT STEP FOR THE BIOBANK

As a prelude to its sample allocation process, the biobank has accepted two pilot projects: one in Quebec on new cancer recurrence markers, and one in the United States on the characterization and complete genome analysis of prostate cancer. The biobank has created an awards committee made up of urologists, pathologists and researchers in prostate cancer.

After six years of intensive work, our biobank has reached a state of maturity that allows it to analyze several factors with respect to the development, progress and treatment of prostate cancer.

THE FUTURE

PROCURE's biobank keeps samples collected from over 2,000 men treated for prostate cancer across Quebec. The biobank wants to provide the worldwide scientific community with equipment

and high-quality clinical, medical, demographic and analytical data in order to facilitate projects covering the largest possible number of areas relevant to prostate cancer.

All participating patients can be very proud of their donation and the excellent tool they have created! More than ever, we are convinced that the biobank will position PROCURE as a world leader in advanced research that will have a significant impact on preventing and curing this cancer.

Held annually since 2006, the PROCURE Walk of Courage is an education and awareness building fundraiser that has seen thousands of men and their families join PROCURE to break the silence surrounding prostate cancer and pay tribute to all those who have fought or who are still fighting this illness.

The Walk of Courage has raised a significant amount of funds since its first edition, and each year Jean Pagé, Robin Burns and Father John Walsh gather well-known figures from the Quebec sports community and lead them in a 5-km tour of Montreal's Saint Helen's Island.

The list of renowned former Walk of Courage Honorary Presidents includes NHL luminaries Pat Burns (2007), Henri Richard (2008), Dickie Moore (2009), Yvan Cournoyer (2010) and Guy Lafleur (2013). PROCURE's Tour of Courage is a two-day cycling event started in 2010 by Laurent Proulx, the current Executive Director of PROCURE. IF YOU ARE DIAGNOSED

CANCER... we all know what this word means: a patient, sitting in front of an uncomfortable-looking doctor who must deliver the dreaded diagnosis. The patient returns home despondently, wracked with a full gamut of emotions ranging from disbelief and confusion to anger, sadness and fear.

We are here to help him. To support his family, friends, loved ones. We are here for anyone who is concerned or worried about prostate cancer.

For the patient's family and friends, the news will come as a shock.

This patient is a man: uncle, neighbour, colleague; a rock singer; an executive. Just about anyone, actually. Perhaps you. This man has

just been told that he has contracted prostate cancer. Beyond the initial shock, he worries about his self-worth as a man, and about his sex life and intimate relationship with his loved one. He realizes that from now on, nothing will be the same. He might want to be alone, bury his emotions and forgo any help outside of the medical context. Yet, there is help – in particular at PROCURE – and very good reasons to remain hopeful.



OUR CONFERENCES

OUR PROSTATE CANCER SUPPORT AND AWARENESS GROUP NETWORK



We strive to exercise judgement and caution when seeking the right balance between managing our financial resources and those costs that are necessary to carry out our mission.





INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

TO THE DIRECTORS OF PROCURE ALLIANCE

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of the organization PROCURE ALLIANCE, which comprise the statements of resources as at December 31, 2013, and the statements of financial activities and changes in resources, of resources and cash flows for the year ended at December 31, 2013, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE FINANCIAL **STATEMENTS**

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

AUDITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing

standard. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion with reserve.



BASIS OF OPINION WITH RESERVE

As is the case in many charities, the organization has income for which it is not possible to audit satisfactorily if they were all accounted for. Accordingly, our audit of these revenues was limited to amounts recorded in the ledger and we could not determine if any adjustments might be necessary to the amounts of donations received, net results, the asset and net assets.

OPINION WITH RESERVE

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments that we might have determined necessary had we been able to audit all the donations mentioned in the paragraph "basis of opinion with reserve", the financial statements give, in all material respects, fairly the financial condition of PROCURE ALLIANCE as at December 31, 2013, and its results of operations and its cash flows for the year ended December 31, 2013 in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations.


